Director of Music Ministry Position Description

Description:

This is a salaried, part time position that is responsible for the overall music ministry of Emmanuel Lutheran Church that includes leading Adult Choir, Praise Team, Children's Church, Creative Ministry Music, and special music programs of the church.

The Director of Music Ministry will work with the Pastor and Worship Committee in planning music appropriate to the Church's seasonal calendar, church's liturgy, and Bible readings. Music for Sunday morning worship services and other special events is discussed and coordinated with the Director of Music Ministry and the Pastor prior to rehearsals. The Director of Music Ministry reports to the Pastor and the President of the Congregation.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Plans all worship service music, leads all scheduled practices and performances of the Adult Choir, Praise Team, Children's Church and scheduled special music events.
- Support all Church seasonal calendar services music needs for the regularly scheduled special services, such as Ash Wednesday, Lenten Midweek services, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, Advent Midweek services and Christmas Eve, and special events, etc.
- Manage the licensing requirements for all purchased or downloaded music to ensure license compliance and prevent broadcast service interruptions due to unlicensed performed music.
- Provide individuals with music and vocal guidance and training to all music ministry participants.

Other duties as may be assigned.

Desired Minimum Education and/or Training:

- Bachelor's degree in music and four years' experience directing higher education choral groups, choirs, and soloist.
- Exceptional abilities and proven proficiencies playing the piano and other musical instruments.
- Demonstrated ability to lead, direct, and inspire others with a Christian faith-based servant leadership style.
